Scholarships

At the HCC Foundation, we support Hillsborough Community College in its mission to deliver affordable educational opportunities that help students become successful citizens. Last year, the Foundation gave 740 scholarships for a total of more than \$640,000. These funds went to deserving students who are the first in their families to attend college, students among the more than 50% of our population who are minorities, workforce students who will go on to form the backbone of our community, and many other students for whom receiving scholarship funds from the Foundation enabled them to enroll, excel, and complete.

Workforce Development Support



From welding to diesel engine tech, from auto collision repair to EMT, police and fire training, HCC provides our community with the career professionals that make our city run. HCC's Division of Workforce Development

offers practical, effective and affordable ways to meet the labor needs in the Tampa Bay area and change students' lives. The Foundation has awarded more than 200 Workforce scholarships since our inception.

Events that Make a Difference



The HCC Foundation team put on two events last year, the Hawks, Line & Sinker In-Shore Fishing Tournament and the Golf Classic. Proceeds from the Hawks, Line & Sinker Fishing Tournament support scholarships

for HCC students enrolled in Workforce Training programs, including Automotive Service Technology, Auto Collision Repair, Welding Technology, Diesel Technology, and the Police and Fire Academies. The Golf Classic supports our HCC Athletics Program, making sure our scholar athletes are able to succeed at both their academic and athletic pursuits. Combined, these two events netted \$117,000 for our students.
