FAQs**

***NEW* REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Teams must submit all angler names at least three days prior to the tournament to enter the Westshore Yacht Club (WYC).
2. Anglers and volunteers MUST wear face coverings upon arrival at WYC. We will provide filtered gaiter-type masks, but please bring your own as well.
3. Anglers and volunteers will have their temperature taken by HCC staff before entering the WYC prior to the tournament.
4. Each company team will be assigned a table as their gathering spot. Gaiter masks, shirts, tournament chips, hand sanitizers, tournament rules, and other tournament tchotchkes will be on the table. Please remain at your table as much as possible. If you must leave your table, please put on a mask.
5. HCC tournament registration representatives will have placed registration sheets on the company assigned table with information on each angler (name, cell phone, email, and chip number). Team members will need to confirm angler registration information or make substitute changes. An HCC representative will pick up the sheets before the tournament begins and make necessary changes for registration.
6. All boat Captains will have their temperature taken prior to anglers boarding.
7. Once Captain Mike Anderson announces the captains have arrived and the boats are ready, teams will line up on the dock 6 feet apart and proceed to their boat, observing social distancing from other teams and captains at all times.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS IN PLACE FOR COVID-19

Hillsborough Community College Foundation is taking precautions to ensure that all participants, staff, and volunteers are as safe as possible concerning possible COVID-19 infections.

The following changes have been made for 2020:

- **CAPTAIN REQUEST will not be allowed for this year's tournament**
- Hand sanitizing stations will be scattered throughout the pool deck and individual sanitizing products will be located in angler tournament bags on tables
- Participants will receive tournament filtered face gaiters. ALL anglers must have a face covering while in registration areas
- Volunteers and staff will be provided with face masks
- All participants and volunteers must read and sign a COVID-19 waiver
- All Captains will have their temperature taken before boarding

WHAT TIME IS REGISTRATION? WHERE DO I GO?

Registration is from 7:30 to 9:00 a.m. at Westshore Yacht Club - 6003 Beacon Shores St, Tampa, FL 33616. Once you arrive, you will receive a table number for your team and you are encouraged to report to your team table.

WHAT IS INCLUDED WITH MY REGISTRATION AND WHAT AM I RESPONSIBLE FOR?

Registration includes a Captain as your guide, use of a boat, bait, all equipment, tournament shirt, gaiter-style masks with a filter, beverages on the boat (water, Gatorade, beer), bagged lunch during fishing, and after-tournament grab and go (or stay) grub.

You are encouraged to PLEASE bring cash to tip your captain.

Anglers are responsible for their own drinks (other than those provided), sunscreen, sunglasses, etc.

IS FOOD PROVIDED?

Of course!

- **Breakfast:**
During registration, we will provide individually wrapped breakfast sandwiches and coffee provided by McDonald's and a Bloody Mary Bar sponsored by Reno Building.
- **Lunch:**
Each boat will be provided five lunches (including one for the captain) provided by Jersey Mike's.
- **Afternoon Grub:**
When your team arrives back at the Westshore Yacht Club, each angler will be provided a boxed burrito meal. Anglers are welcome to sit with their team at their designated table or take the food to go.
