- Secure nationally acclaimed experts and prominent speakers who share research solutions with practitioners and college administrators to assist Black and Latino males on college campuses across the nation.


Opportunities to Support

Summit Opportunities

Scholarship Opportunities

A portion of the proceeds from the Summit supports Hillsborough Community College's HOPE Scholars Program. The HOPE Scholars Program is designed to improve retention, graduation and four-year college transfer rates of Black and Hispanic male students enrolled at HCC. Students are provided with a faculty mentor, academic monitoring, support services and college tours.
